The Village of Hainesville will receive sealed proposals for the following improvement project at the Village Clerk's office, 100 North Hainesville Rd., Hainesville, Illinois 60030, until **10:00 AM on Thursday, September 13, 2018**.

FORCE MAIN AIR RELEASE VALVES REPLACEMENT

Proposals will be publicly read aloud at the Village Hall at **10:01 AM on Thursday, September 13, 2018**. No proposal shall be withdrawn after the opening of the proposals without the consent of the Mayor and Board of Trustees for a period of forty-five (45) days after the scheduled time of closing of the receipt of proposals.

All proposals shall be sealed in an envelope, addressed to the Village of Hainesville, Attn.: Village Clerk. The name and address of the bidder and the name of the project shall also appear on the outside of the envelope. Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided by the Engineer.

The Proposal Documents, including specifications, are on file at the office of the Engineer, Robinson Engineering, Ltd., 26575 W Commerce Dr, Suite 512, Volo, Illinois 60073 and may be obtained from the office upon a non-refundable payment of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per paper copy and/or Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per CD format. The documents will be issued until 4:00 PM on the last business day preceding the bid. No refund will be made for documents received from the office. The Contractor shall submit a current Robinson Engineering Prequalification Statement which will be reviewed by the Engineer prior to receiving the Proposal Documents.

A performance bond in a sum equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the proposal, with sureties to be approved by the Village of Hainesville for the faithful performance of the contract, must be furnished by the successful bidder. All proposals shall contain an offer to furnish bond upon acceptance of such proposal.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, to postpone the proposal opening, or to advertise for new proposals, if in the judgment of the Village of Hainesville their best interests will be promoted thereby.

The contractor will be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates on this project as established by the Illinois Department of Labor. He shall also comply with all applicable Federal, State, and local regulations.

Contractor qualifications and experience will also be included in the basis for determining the lowest responsible proposal. Prequalifications will be required to be submitted to the Engineer by all potential bidders. If, in the opinion of the Engineer and the Village of Hainesville, an applicant would not be able to serve the best interest of the Village, a proposal will not be issued to the applicant.
