YARD WASTE SEASON – SINGLE FAMILY HOMES

Yard waste season runs from April 3rd thru November 27th, 2019. Yard waste may be disposed of in a paper disposable yard waste bag or a standard marked yard waste container. Branches must be bundled. They may not exceed 4 feet in length, 18 inches in diameter or weigh over 50 pounds. Yard waste material that is not properly prepared will not be collected. If your garbage/recycling/yard waste is not picked up, **PLEASE call Advanced Disposal directly at 847-623-3870.**

Avon Township is a partner with the Diaper Bank Partnership of Lake County and there is a need for Diapers. Diapers are accepted anytime for babies (sizes 4,5,6 & Toddler sizes), the elderly and the disabled!

- Food Stamps, Link, WIC, Public Aid and Medicare do not cover diapers.
- 15 - 20% of all adults over age 65 suffer some degree of incontinence!
- A healthy change of diapers costs \$100 a month or more for all ages.

April 1st – Last day for early voting at State mandated extended hour sites. (Gurnee Village Hall, Jane Addams Center, Lake County Clerk's Office, Lake County Courthouse and Administrative Complex, North Chicago City Hall)

April 2nd – ELECTION DAY 6:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. (All Hainesville residents vote at Hainesville Village Hall) For Hainesville, it is an uncontested race. There are 3 Candidates for 3 Trustee positions.

- **RECEIVE YOUR UTILITY BILL VIA EMAIL (PAPERLESS)** - help your Village and environment by saving time and money with the costs of paper, envelopes, cartridge ink, postage and staff time. Your bill is emailed the day it is produced.
- **SET UP AUTOMATIC DEBIT PAYMENTS** - You choose which account is used to pay your bill. A bill is produced and emailed/mailed so you know exactly how much will be deducted. Money is not taken out of your account until the due date! Avoid those penalties and sign up today!
- **SET UP CREDIT / DEBIT CARD RECURRING PAYMENTS** - This is the latest enhancement for payments. Our online payment processor, Point and Pay, offers the option to set up a recurring electronic payment using a CREDIT or DEBIT CARD. Many residents enjoy this latest feature! Set up your credit card account and earn those points!
- **HAVE ONLINE ACCESS TO REVIEW YOUR UTILITY ACCOUNT AND TO MAKE A PAYMENT.** Misplaced your bill? You can review your account online to see your balance and review your history. Your PIN number is required to access your account. The PIN is on the Upper Right Hand Side of your Utility Bill or call the office for the PIN. While reviewing your account you may make your payment at this time as well.
