Hainesville Village Hall is a Drop Off Site for the Avon Township Diaper Drive

Avon Township is a partner with the Diaper Bank Partnership of Lake County and there is a need for Diapers. Diapers are accepted anytime for babies (sizes 4,5,6 & Toddler sizes), the elderly and the disabled!

- Food Stamps, Link, WIC, Public Aid and Medicare do not cover diapers.
- 15 - 20% of all adults over age 65 suffer some degree of incontinence!
- A healthy change of diapers costs \$100 a month or more for all ages

Yard Waste Season – Single Family Homes



Yard waste season runs from April 3rd thru November 27th, 2019. Yard waste may be disposed of in a paper disposable yard waste bag or a standard marked yard waste container. Branches must be bundled. They may not exceed 4 feet in length, 18 inches in diameter or weigh over 50 pounds. Yard waste material that is not properly prepared will not be collected. If your garbage/recycling/yard waste is not picked up, PLEASE call Advanced Disposal directly at 847-623-3870.

Sewer Rate Increase Notification

Lake County Public Works Department has notified the Village that the North Shore Water Reclamation District User Charge Fees have increased. The Village has no input nor control over this cost increase. This increase is passed onto the residents and businesses. The increase is effective April 1, 2019 and will show on your April utility bill when that usage is billed.

This increase affects the Northeast Central Sewer System customers which are comprised of the subdivisions of Misty Hill Farms, Deer Point Trails, The Sanctuary and The Settlement. The sewer rate will increase from \$5.551 per thousand gallons to \$6.184 per thousand gallons. The total increase is \$0.633 per thousand gallons.

Information like home/work addresses, vehicle details, medical conditions, adults, children & pets in the household can be provided in this secure profile accessed only if you dial 9-1-1.
