SEWER RATE INCREASE NOTIFICATION

Lake County Public Works Department recently completed a system wide rate fee study. As a result of the study **the Lake County Board approved sanitary sewer rate increases** for customer's tributary to the Northeast Central Region and the Northwest Region. These increases are passed onto the residents and businesses. This increase is effective with the usage starting on December 1, 2019 and will be reflected on your January utility bill.

Northeast Central Sewer Region customers are comprised of the subdivisions of Misty Hill Farms, Deer Point Trails, The Sanctuary and The Settlement. The sewer rate will increase from \$6.184 per 1,000 gallons to \$6.324 per 1,000 gallons. The total increase is \$0.14 per 1,000 gallons.

Northwest Sewer Region customers are comprised of the subdivisions of Union Square Townhomes, Cranberry Lake (both single family homes and all townhomes) and the Commercial corridor on Routes 120 & 134. The sewer rate will increase from \$3.70 per 1,000 gallons to \$3.76 per 1,000 gallons. The total increase is \$0.06 per 1,000 gallons.

Waste containers and recycling containers are to be stored at the side or rear of the residence, except **from three p.m. on the day prior to collection to eight p.m. on the day of collection**, when the waste containers and recycling containers may be placed at the curb. Waste containers shall be placed on the curb on the day of collection by six a.m.
