As an American, one of your rights and duties is to **VOTE**. It's your chance to influence how government works. It is your chance to help decide what America will be. Please take this opportunity to register for the March primary and the November presidential election. **Your vote, no matter for whom you vote, is valuable.**

March 17, 2020 is the General Primary election and

November 3, 2020 is the Presidential election

YOU CAN REGISTER TO VOTE at the Village Hall, 100 N. Hainesville Road any Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. **LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE AT THE VILLAGE HALL IS FEBRUARY 18TH by 4:30 p.m.** Bring your ID to register. Or you can **register online** by clicking the following link: <https://ova.elections.il.gov/>. Finally, you can register to vote at the Village Hall on Election Day.

General Primary Election, March 17, 2020 6:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

February 6 – February 28 – Register to Vote & Early Vote at Lake County Clerk's Office

February 18 – Voter Registration closes at the Village of Hainesville at 4:30 p.m.

February 19 – February 28 – Grace period Registration at Lake County Clerk's Office, 18 N. County St., Room 101, Waukegan, IL 60085, 847-377-2400, Hours are Monday - Friday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Voting by mail – The application is available 90 days before the election and is at the Lake County Clerk's Office.

March 2 – March 14 – Early voting begins. **Closest Early Voting Site for Hainesville is: **NEW LOCATION!**** Avon Township Office, 433 E. Washington St. Round Lake Park, 847-546-1446. Hours are Monday - Friday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

March 14 – **Last day for early voting at non-state mandated sites** (Antioch Twp. Office, Avon Township Office, Ela Township Office, Fremont Township Office, Highland Park Police Station, Lake Barrington Village Hall, Lake County Central Permit Facility, Lake Forest City Hall, Wauconda Township Office, West Deerfield Township, Office William E. Peterson Park and Zion City Hall)

March 16 – **Last day for early voting at State mandated extended hour sites.** (Gurnee Village Hall, Jane Addams Center, Lake County Main Courthouse and North Chicago City Hall)

**March 17 – ELECTION DAY All Hainesville residents vote at
Hainesville Village Hall
6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.**



The U.S. Census Bureau will begin counting every resident in the United States next month. It is critically important that all residents of Lake County are counted. Census population data is used to determine the distribution of about \$675 billion in federal funding to states and local communities. For every person not counted, Lake County loses out in approximately \$1,400 per person per year in federal funding. That money goes to support local schools, health care services, housing, infrastructure and much more.

SHREDDING EVENT

Hainesville will hold a **FREE** document shredding event at the Village Hall tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 13, 2020 from 10 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Each household will be limited to three (3) banker boxes worth of shredding until the shred truck is full. We will also recycle textiles, shoes, socks, glasses and hearing aids. Note that year-round Hainesville recycles electronics and textiles in the Public Works parking lot, and shoes and socks in the lobby of the Village Hall.
