**The Mayor and Village Board are taking the following actions to provide some assistance to our residents and businesses during the Covid-19 crisis.**

**Each occupied single-family residence, occupied townhome, occupied apartment, and business will be given a \$100 water bill credit.** This credit will be noted on your bill going out with this newsletter and future water bills, until the full amount has been expended. Please note that you will still be responsible for the sewer and garbage portion of the bill.

**For townhome residents,** the credit will be issued via your Management/Association with the understanding that the \$100 credit is to be distributed to each residence.

**For those of you in apartments,** the landlord will receive the credit and is responsible for distributing it to the tenants.

**For the Apartments and Townhomes.** If you do not receive the credit by **June**, please contact your Management/Association or landlord and then, if necessary, call the Village Hall.

## Yard Waste Season – Single Family Homes



Yard waste season runs from April 8<sup>th</sup> thru November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Yard waste may be disposed of in a paper disposable yard waste bag or a standard marked yard waste container. Branches must be bundled. They may not exceed 4 feet in length, 18 inches in diameter or weigh over 50 pounds. Yard waste material that is not properly prepared will not be collected. If your garbage/recycling/yard waste is not picked up, PLEASE call Advanced Disposal directly at 847-623-3870.

**SEASONAL LABORERS – PUBLIC WORKS**

Daily duties may include: Tree trimming, tree removal, stump grinding, chipping, raking, watering, lawn mowing and weed trimming. Individuals will assist with the maintenance of the Village's streets and infrastructure, with the repair, construction, and maintenance of Village streets, storm sewers, signage and facilities, pot hole patching, sign replacement, fence repairs, concrete replacement and assisting with storm sewer repairs.

Applicants must be 18 years or older and have a high school diploma or equivalent and a valid Illinois Driver License. Must successfully pass drug and alcohol screening, criminal background and driving record check. Must be able to lift or carry a weight up to 50 lbs.

Hours: up to 40 per week between 7:30 am and 3:30 pm Monday – Friday and occasional Saturdays. Position is from May 1<sup>st</sup> through November 13<sup>th</sup> (flexible) Salary is \$12.00 an hour. No benefits are included.
