APRIL 6TH, 2021 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION PETITION PACKETS AVAILABLE

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic the Village Hall is closed. *Courtesy* Election Petition Packets are available now. Please email kathymetzler@hainesville.org or call Clerk Metzler at 847-223-2032 x12 to request a Courtesy Election Petition Packet. The April 6th, 2021 Consolidated Election will include the following offices to be elected: **Village Mayor – 4-year term of office, Village Trustee – 3 Trustees, each for a 4-year term of office and Village Trustee – 1 Trustee, 2-year unexpired term of office.**

The first date to circulate the nominating petition packets was Tuesday, September 22nd, 2020 through Monday, December 21st, 2020.

The first day to file your Nominating Petition Packets at the Village of Hainesville is on Monday, December 14th, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. and the last day to file is Monday, December 21st, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. The Village Hall will be open Monday, December 14th through Thursday, December 17th from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Monday, December 21st, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

POSTAGE-FREE DROP BOXES FOR VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS OPEN SEPTEMBER 24TH

If you received a ballot by mail and do not want to return it through the U.S. Postal Service, take advantage of the many postage-free drop boxes around the County. Election judges will collect ballots daily and bring them to the Lake County Clerk's office for processing. VACUUM SERVICE – YARD WASTE PICK-UP SINGLE FAMILY HOMES

Leaf vacuuming service will be offered on Wednesdays starting October 21st and ending on November 25th. Please be aware that due to the volume of leaves any particular week, the leaf collection truck may not always arrive at your home the same time each week. Please have your leaves ready for pickup by 6:30 a.m. on Wednesdays. Last day for yard waste pick-up is also November 25th.

INSTRUCTIONS: Leaves should be raked into a pile or row within 3 feet of the curb but remaining well off the street. Please make sure to keep the leaves on the parkway and not in the street. Please do not mix large tree branches, grass, or brush with your pile of leaves as these items will damage the vacuum truck. **If the weather won't cooperate & there is bad weather on a Wednesday, the leaves will be picked up the very next day or ASAP. RV & BOAT, SNOWMOBILE & TRAILER PARKING ORDINANCE

Boats, their trailers, campers, etc. may be temporarily stored in driveways from April 1st to October 31st ONLY. Snowmobiles and their trailers may be temporarily stored in driveways between November 1st and March 31st ONLY.

OVERNIGHT PARKING REQUEST

If you need to park your vehicle on the street overnight you can now make your request on our website in the right-hand upper corner there is a button labeled "Request Overnight Parking". This goes directly to the Police Department.
