### APRIL 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION PETITION PACKETS AVAILABLE

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic the Village Hall is closed. Courtesy Election Petition Packets are available now. The April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Consolidated Election will include the following offices to be elected: **Village Mayor – 4-year term of office, Village Trustee – 3 Trustees, each for a 4-year term of office and Village Trustee – 1 Trustee, 2-year unexpired term of office.**

The circulation dates for the nominating petition packets is Tuesday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 through Monday, December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

The first day to file your Nominating Petition Packets at the Village of Hainesville is on Monday, December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. and the last day to file is Monday, December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. The Village Hall will be open Monday, December 14<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, December 17<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Monday, December 21<sup>st</sup>, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

## **LEAF VACUUM SERVICE – YARD WASTE PICK-UP SINGLE FAMILY HOMES**

Leaf vacuuming service will be offered on Wednesdays which started October 21<sup>st</sup>, will be ending on November 25<sup>th</sup>. Please be aware that due to the volume of leaves any particular week, the leaf collection truck may not always arrive at your home at the same time each week. Please have your leaves ready for pickup by 6:30 a.m. on Wednesdays. Last day for yard waste pick-up is also November 25<sup>th</sup>.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Leaves should be raked into a pile or row within 3 feet of the curb but remaining well off the street. **Please make sure to keep the leaves on the parkway and not in the street.** Please do not mix large tree branches, grass, or brush with your pile of leaves as these items will damage the vacuum truck. **If the weather won't cooperate & there is bad weather on a Wednesday, the leaves will be picked up the very next day or ASAP. ## **RV & BOAT, SNOWMOBILE & TRAILER PARKING ORDINANCE**

Boats, their trailers, campers, etc. may be temporarily stored in driveways from April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> ONLY. Snowmobiles and their trailers may be temporarily stored in driveways between November 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup> ONLY.

If you need to park your vehicle on the street overnight you can now make your request on our website in the right-hand upper corner there is a button labeled "Request Overnight Parking". This goes directly to the Police Department.
