## **HAINESVILLE SEWER RATE INCREASE NOTIFICATION**

The Hainesville Village Board passed an ordinance to increase the Hainesville Sewer portion of your Utility Bill. This increase will be effective May 1, 2022 and will reflect on your utility bill received in June. The current Hainesville sewer rate of \$0.50 per thousand gallons will be increased to \$1.00 per thousand gallons. The last Hainesville Sewer increase was in May 2013. This increase is necessary to maintain funds for maintenance, repair, and replacement of the village sewer service lines.

## **AVON TOWNSHIP GENERATORS AND FLOOD CLEANUP EQUIPMENT**

All flood mitigation equipment is available to our residents such as gas generators, extension cords, fans, dehumidifiers, shop vac's, water pumps and garden hoses. The generators are available for medical emergencies. Avon Township will loan out the equipment free of charge to residents but will need to provide a credit card to have on file.
