Village of Hainesville Refuse & Recycling Reminders

When should refuse be put at the curb?

Trash, recyclables and yard waste should be at the curb by 6 am on Monday. Items can be set out after 3 pm on the day prior. All containers need to be removed no later than 8 pm on collection day.

What if my trash does not fit in the cart?

If you have more refuse than will fit in your cart, please place it in either plastic bags of 32 gallons or smaller containers that weigh less than 50 pounds and can be managed by one person.

What if Waste Management misses my garbage pick up?

If your trash is missed by Waste Management on Monday, it must be called in by Tuesday morning in order for Waste Management to go back and pick it up within the week. Contact Waste Management at 800-796-9696 or 877-793-1559 for a missed pickup.

What can I do with large items that do not fit in the refuse cart?

Each resident is allowed one bulk item per week at no charge. Bulk items include any regular household furniture, i.e., couch, chair, mattress. Rolls of carpet are bulk items as well. Carpet needs to be rolled less than 6 feet in length, manageable by one person and weigh 50 pounds or less. How do I dispose of large appliances?

Waste Management does pick up appliances. For this service you do need to contact Waste Management at 800-796-9696 or 877-793-1559 for a special pick up.

How do I get rid of construction waste?

Small amounts of construction materials which can fit into a single 33 gallon container and weighs less than 50 pounds may be set out for normal weekly collection. There is a charge for any type of building material, such as wood, drywall, and fencing, etc. Contact Waste Management at 800-796-9696 or 877-793-1559

What do I do if I have a broken trash can or recycle bin?

Holiday Collection Schedule

Holidays which may affect the schedule are: New years Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, and Christmas Day.
