The first date to circulate the nominating petition packets is Tuesday, September 20th, 2022 through Monday, December 19th, 2022. Our hours are Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The first day to file your Nominating Petition Packets at the Village of Hainesville is on Monday, December 12th, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. and the last day to file is Monday, December 19th, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. The Village Hall will be open Monday, December 12th, through Thursday, December 15th, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Monday, December 19th, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
