SNOW AND ICE

- No street parking is permitted during or after a 2-inch snowfall to allow crews to clear the road from curb to curb. The exception is vehicles parked on Holiday Ln., W. Big Horn Dr. and Triumph Ct. There is no parking between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. the day after two inches or more of snowfall.
- Give snowplows room to work.
- Please clear your sidewalks of snow and ice. Also, let's look out for neighbors who might not be able to remove snow on their own by lending a helping hand.
- When removing snow from your driveway, be sure NOT to push it into the street.
- Please clean snow and ice away from Fire Hydrants in your area.
- Snowmobiling or ATV's are not allowed to be used anywhere within the village limits.
- If your sump pump line is discharging into the street or onto a sidewalk, please move it as this freezes and creates dangerous ice situations.
