- **Confidential Documents** for Shredding—Max of 6 banker boxes per vehicle (until truck full). **NO BUSINESSES: Household personal/confidential docs only (taxes, bank/credit card statements.etc).** Recycle mail, envelopes, coupons, magazines, & other paper in your home Curbside Recycling Bin. **99%+ of paper from home is recyclable curbside.**
- **Shoes**—all types Footwear. Tie pairs together w/laces; if no laces, rubber band or zip-tie. **No Rollerblades or ice skates.**
- **Stuffed/Plush Animals, Dolls, & Toys**
No other toys. Only All Plush/Stuffies
- **Clothing**—New, Gently Used or Worn (all sizes, fabrics, types). Your donations of new and gently used will be reused & allow us to recycle worn items received. Includes pet clothing, and costumes. Clean/Bagged.
- **Accessories: Belts, Scarves, Hats, Purses, Duffle Bags, & Backpacks**
- **Bed & Table Linens, and Towels** (including sheets, comforters, quilts, blankets, tablecloths, etc.) **No pillow, cushions or rugs.**
- **Keys & U.S. Flags (for retirement)**
- **Fire Extinguishers & Automotive Batteries.** **No other batteries.**
- **CO & Smoke Detectors**
- **New & gently used pet leashes, collars & small pet carriers**
- **Books for Reuse: NO Wet, Damaged. Moldy or Odorous Books • Phone Books • Magazines • “FREE” Government books • Newspapers • Time Life Books • Coloring Books • Encyclopedias**
- **For Food Pantry—only these items accepted:**
1) Peanut Butter 2) Spaghetti Sauce 3) Pasta
4) Canned Soups and Stews 5) Rice
