- An Ordinance Amending Sections of the Village of Hainesville Code of Ordinance Regarding Zoning – This text amendment is to create a zoning classification that recognizes a gun club as a special use and establishes standards for the use.
- 2. An Ordinance Granting a Special Use Permit to the Northbrook Sports Club for a Gun Club for the Property Commonly Known as 160 Sports Club Drive, Hainesville, Illinois If the text amendment is approved, this Special Use Permit will be considered. It eliminates the non-conforming use of the Northbrook Sports Club and grants a special use for a gun club in the AG-Agricultural Zoning District.
