Trustee Derenoski stated that they are proposing a balanced budget. Treasurer Kelly Hensley gave an overview of the budget report. She reminded the board that the Village waived Business and Liquor License fees and issued a credit to residents for their Utility Bill. Also the Water Tap Fee account, which is stagnant, will be closed and that money used to pay off IEPA loan.

**Discussion**

Mayor Daley stated that the paving of the Public Works parking lot has been cut and added in was the repair of the clogged Lisk pipe and SCADA improvements and upgrades.

Trustee George Duberstein thanked Kelly for her time in answering his questions. He also asked what happens if a new business gives us tap on fees and the account is closed. The money would then be put into Capital Reserve Water Account.


